DISABILITY POLICY

Landbeach Parish Council recognises its obligation under the Disability Discrimination Act and carries out the following Code of Practice to make every effort to accommodate Councillors and members of the public.

Procedure at meetings for Councillors and members of the public

Wheelchair Users

Meetings are held in the Village Hall, which has a disabled parking space and ramp access from the car park to the Village Hall. The door will remain open until the start of the meeting to enable wheelchair users to access the hall. There is a door bell, which can be accessed from a wheelchair, if people arrive after the meeting has started, so attention can be drawn to them if they are unable to open the door.

Hearing Impaired

The Village Hall has a loop system for the hard of hearing which is available at all meetings.

Other Difficulties

If you think you may have difficulties attending a meeting, that is not outlined above, please contact The Clerk as far in advance as possible and the Parish Council will make every effort to accommodate you at a meeting and if necessary may try to find an alternative room for the meeting

Minutes for Councillors and members of the public

Visually Impaired

Minutes can be produced in large print, or a recorded tape of the minutes can be made available.

Communication to the Council

If any person has a disability which restricts their communication in writing to the Council then the Clerk would take notes from them in order for communication to be made
